Dear Fleetwood Families:

The USDA has announced the extension of the Summer Food Service Program Waiver. They extended the Seamless Summer Option and Summer Food Service Program waivers that allow School Food Authorities to serve free meals to all children/students from the ages of 2-18 in the community until December 31, 2020 (contingent on the continued availability of federal funding). As a result, the FASD will be serving free breakfast and lunch to all students enrolled in the district.

What does this mean for you and your child(ren)?

All FASD students, whether picking up Grab & Go Lunch or eating in a school building will be able to eat both a breakfast, and a lunch for free from now until December 31, 2020.

Should I still fill out the Free/Reduced Application?

We highly recommend that you fill out your application now. When funding runs out, all children with approved application will go back to their eligibility status of free or reduced price meals. If a child does not have a current application on file, they will be charged the full price for meals. Applications are on the Food Service web page or you can apply at www.schoolcafe.com.

How do I order for Grab & Go Lunch pickup?

You must pre-order the week prior by Friday at 12:00 PM (noon) for pick-up the following week. Please use this link to order meals:
