Dear Fleetwood Families,

I am writing to you with the information on the change with instruction at the high school starting Monday, March 8th.

The three models of instruction that will be available for students include:

1. Virtual - Students will attend school in a fully virtual setting
2. Hybrid - Students will attend school two days in person and two days virtually (based upon the current Hybrid Schedule Model)
3. In Person - Students will attend school four days in person

In order to plan for the change, every parent will need to complete this form for each of their students <https://forms.gle/cnFahaMxUaABXzHC8>. Please return this form by the end of the day Monday, February 22nd so that we may make the appropriate scheduling adjustments. If you do not return the form, then we will presume that your child is staying in his/her current model of instruction.

We will continue to follow the modified FASD Health and Safety Plan; however, we want to inform you of key updates and information.

- Students will be at least 3 feet apart in classrooms, which may lead to more students being quarantined due to the contact tracing procedures. Quarantined students will be moved to a separate area until parents are able to pick up their student.
- Masks must be worn properly (covering the mouth and nose) at all times.
 - Mask breaks will still occur when students are able to be six feet apart.
 - Students will remain six feet apart in lunches and be able to have their masks off while eating.

*One-Way Hallway Traffic will remain in effect.

*Please remember to take the necessary precautions and perform regular temperature checks.

*We will remain on our current bell schedule.
